







Vienna, Austria / Days 1 – 2

Explore Vienna's cultural capital, from the imperial Hofburg Palace to the centuries-old St. Stephen's Cathedral. Venture into a traditional coffeehouse for a taste of famed Viennese pastries, watch a demonstration of the renowned Lipizzaner horses, or opt for a day trip to the Slovakian capital, Bratislava. *Hotel Sacher Vienna*

Sofia, Bulgaria / Days 3 – 4

From one of the largest cathedral in the Balkans to communist-era monuments, Sofia's landscape reflects the country's storied past. After exploring the city, head out into the countryside to the alpine Seven Rila Lakes, visit the Rila Monastery, or discover the ancient city of Plovdiv, known for its wine and Roman history. *Hilton Sofia*

Tbilisi, Georgia / Days 5 – 6

Explore Old Tbilisi, where you'll find medieval architecture and some of the country's oldest churches. Visit the historic bath district along the right bank of the Mtkvari River. Take a half-day trip to one of the oldest winemaking regions in the world, or venture into an ancient cave city in the countryside. *Stamba Hotel*

Bukhara, Uzbekistan / Days 7 – 8

Bukhara's historic center brings you back to a time when this ancient city was a fabled trading outpost on the Silk Road. Explore this UNESCO World Heritage site before stopping at a local tea house for an authentic experience and celebrating our visit with dinner at the Summer Palace. *Zargaron Plaza Hotel*

Baku, Azerbaijan / Days 9 – 10

Various cultural influences, from Persian to Russian, have melded together in Baku's ancient walled city, which is a UNESCO World Heritage site. Explore the Old Town on a private tour, visit a unique fire temple, see how ancient carpet weaving traditions are being preserved or view the collection at the modern art museum. *Four Seasons Hotel Baku*

Yerevan, Armenia / Days 11 – 12

Armenia was the first country to adopt Christianity as its official state religion. Visit the world's oldest cathedral and stunning medieval monasteries in the countryside. Travel even further back in time at a 2,000-year-old Hellenic temple and examine the archaeological collection of the National History Museum. *The Alexander.*

Montenegro / Days 13 – 15

Montenegro has something for every type of traveler, whether you prefer exploring a serene lake, hiking through a national park, strolling through a well-preserved medieval town or sampling the catch of the day. However you choose to spend your three days here, you will be well-rewarded. *Regent Porto Montenegro*

Budapest, Hungary / Days 16 – 18

Budapest offers much more than just stunning architecture. You can visit Central Europe's largest freshwater lake, relax in a historic thermal bath or go wine tasting in the countryside. Celebrate your journey with a festive farewell dinner, before returning on your independent flight the next day. *Four Seasons Hotel Gresham Palace Budapest*
